We hope you find this brochure useful, whilst you make this important decision for yourself or your relative.



The French doors and large bay windows in our main lounge offer our residents a magnificent, panoramic view of the charming landscaped garden. Two of our lounges are equipped with large flat screen televisions, DVD players and high quality sound systems to provide recreation and entertainment.

Those who enjoy peaceful relaxation can take advantage of the quiet sitting room and our small library of books, whilst our glass walled conservatory allows residents to delight in the picturesque outdoors in all seasons.

Our well-appointed dining areas are spacious and smartly arranged in restaurant style, so you can choose to dine with family or friends, or alone if you prefer. Here, too, one can enjoy the view of the beautiful grounds outside.





Communal Areas

All the communal areas of Hallamshire are bright and spacious, spotlessly clean and attractively decorated. A maintenance person is employed to keep the home in perfect order. The home is suitably designed for easy wheelchair use. All doors are extra wide, 2 lifts provide access to the bedrooms on the other two floors and there is level access to all outdoor areas enabling our less mobile residents to benefit from the lovely garden. All the corridors and bathrooms are fitted with handrails.



Landscaped Gardens

At the rear of the home is a beautiful landscaped garden. A vast lawn, numerous trees, shrubs, and gorgeous flowers are regularly tended by our skilled gardener. In all seasons, the grounds are kept neat and pretty and provide scenic and peaceful surroundings. The generous seating is particularly well used and appreciated in warm weather by residents and visitors.

OUR TEAM

Hallamshire is owned by Carewise Homes
Group and is run by Care Manager, Karen Betts
. Karen has many years' managerial experience
in care, holds a Registered Managers Award,
NVQ4 in Care and is trained in many areas
including Dementia Care, Challenging
Behaviour, First Aid and Dementia Care
Mapping.

Our outstanding care team are also dedicated and highly qualified; most have completed NVQ levels 2 or 3 or are working toward Healthcare Diplomas. We insist on a high standard of care, so our employees are carefully selected, full induction training is provided and continuing

professional development is undertaken by each member of staff.

Attentive and compassionate carers are available twenty four hours a day. The high staff-resident ratio enables us to provide companionship and stimulation, as well as tending to your physical needs.

In addition to the Care staff, Hallamshire also employs an activities co-ordinator, expert cook, domestic staff, catering and kitchen assistants and a maintenance person. Our Home has been awarded the Investors in People standard, demonstrating our commitment to our staff and residents.

Your Health

The prime objective of our home is to promote and foster health and well-being. On your admission, an assessment of need will be performed by a senior member of the care team, from which a Care Plan will be created. You, your relatives and doctors will be offered and encouraged to participate in the drafting

of your Care Plan. A review is conducted monthly, unless changes in your condition necessitate more frequent reviews.

When you join the home, we recommend that you join our local doctors' practice. This allows for close interaction between our care team and the GP.







Your Well-being

In case of illness, your relatives will be informed immediately and will be updated regularly on your recovery. If your family members wish to be present whilst you are ill, we can help arrange suitable accommodation for them. If you are using the home for convalescent purposes, you will be attended by a rehabilitation team to prepare you for discharge home.

In addition, you are invited to benefit from:

- music therapy
- hair-dressing
- manicures
- dentist
- optician
- chiropodist
- occupational therapy as needed
- physiotherapy therapy as needed

Recreational Activities

At Hallamshire, we offer you a varied and stimulating programme of entertaining activities. Besides the weekly activities plan, there is a collection of books, DVD players, large flat-screen televisions, high quality sound systems and newspapers delivered daily. The Hallamshire newsletter is published every two months with news and views of events and trips. Singers and entertainers are invited frequently to the home and add excitement and inspiration to our programme.

We encourage our residents to pursue their own interests and hobbies and staff are delighted to assist whenever necessary. Family members and the community are always welcome to volunteer with activities and events and new ideas are most appreciated.


Events & Trips
